

Quilt Binding Class

Slightly Biased Quilts

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Description: The Quilt Binding class walks students through the steps of making and attaching quilt binding to a quilt. Students will bring pre-cut strips of fabric and enjoy the use of a binding machine that will do all the ironing for them! Then students will attach the binding to their quilt, by machine for the front side and then finishing the back side by hand. This class is excellent for anyone who needs a little help in making their binding more precise and clean!

Materials Needed:

- Quilt of any size (quilted and trimmed but not bound)
- Strips of binding fabric cut at 2 ½ inches wide, at the appropriate length for the quilt
- Thread matching the binding fabric or backing fabric
- Clover clips (included in kit at quilt shows)
- Small scissors (included in kit at quilt shows)
- Hand-sewing needle (included in kit at quilt shows)
- Sewing gauge or other small ruler (included in kit at quilt shows)
- Sewing machine and supplies/accessories (don't forget the power cord!) with a walking foot
